Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Any 4-H member who is enrolled in the current 4-H year Dog Project and has trained their own dog or under the supervision of a leader may compete.
- 2. Space is limited so please only sign up for the event(s) that you still need to qualify for the State Fair.
- 3. A copy of proof of current vaccinations MUST accompany registration.
- 4. No dogs in season will be allowed to show. And all dogs must be six months of age or older at the date of show to enter.
- 5. The exhibitor is expected to handle, groom, and exercise the dog while at the show location.
- 6. Any dog showing aggression or attacking another dog or person at the show may be asked to leave immediately. Any abuse to the dog on the grounds or in the ring will result in disqualification.
- 7. Entries may be made in a higher classification, but cannot regress past prior accomplishments. (See Guidelines for KS 4-H Dog Shows).
- 8. In obedience, agility, & rally a dog may be entered in only one class. All classes are open to mixed breeds & purebred dogs.
- 9. No baiting or grooming equipment of any kind will be allowed in the rings.
- 10. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times, except when competing in "off leash" exercises.
- 11. Dogs must be kept in kennels except when competing or outside the ring waiting to compete.
- 12. No dogs will be allowed in the ring before classes.

- 13. The Wyandotte County Dog Club will not be responsible for any loss, theft, injury, or death of dogs or persons entered or attending the show.
