Some ideas might include, but are not limited to professionalism, decision making, career preparation, workplace skills, citizenship, character, communication, conflict management, ethics, motivation, initiatives, leading by example, time management, using your resources, goal setting, leadership after high school, getting involved, international citizenship, diversity and business etiquette. We are looking for new and exciting lessons to give KYLF a fresh workshop selection.

Please consider offering the topic during more than one session on Saturday. Presentations that **involve** the audience have been the most effective in past years.

If you know of others who would be good presenters or facilitators, please share this information with them as well. **Proposals are due May 15.** The Youth Council will be reviewing proposals in late June. Selected presenters will be notified in July. Presenters who are not attending KYLF with a local unit delegation are invited to lunch and/or to listen to the forum keynote speaker on Saturday, November 22. Additional information will be sent to presenters before the Forum.
