

## Kansas State 4-H Horse Show High Point Rules

Adopted May 2023

- Three divisions of high-point will be awarded: Speed Events, Ranch Horse, Performance.
  - Speed Events: Barrel Race, Flag Race, Pole Bending
  - Ranch Horse: Ranch Trail Ranch Pattern, Ranch Rail, Reining
  - Performance: Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Hunter Hack, Trail, Western Horsemanship, Western Pleasure
- Award points will be given for the horse/rider pair.
- Banners will be awarded to the Top 5 exhibitors in each division and each age division.
- There will be one buckle awarded in each age group for the 1st place horse/rider pair in each division.
- In the case of a tie, the award will be given to the contestant with the highest placing in the following:
  - Speed- Barrels
  - Ranch- Reining
  - Performance- Trail
- Award points will be based on the following:
  - The maximum number of horses placed in each class will be 10.
  - The number of horses in a class will be determined by the number that actually show.
- The point scale below will be used.
