Kearny County 4-H Shooting Sports is hosting a 4-H Archery State Match Qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 9-18. State match rules will be followed. All 4 disciplines offered.

Note: Minimum age to participate in the State Match is 9 years old by Jan 1, 2025.

Registration is due by 5:00 PM on July 25, 2025. Late registration will only be accepted to fill flight relays. We will only accept registration from one person per county. NO REFUNDS OR SUBSTITUTIONS.

To qualify for state (Time Limit: 4 minutes per 6 arrows):

\Rightarrow Juniors age 9-13	12 arrows at 30 meters and 12 arrows at 20 meters.
\Rightarrow Seniors age 14-18	12 arrows at 40 meters and 12 arrows at 30 meters.
Minimum Qualifying Scores:	
\Rightarrow Recurve - Bare Bow	120 out of a possible 240
\Rightarrow Recurve - Olympic	140 out of a possible 240
\Rightarrow Compound - Bowhunter	200 out of a possible 240
\Rightarrow Compound - Open	210 out of a possible 240
Awards will be given to top 3 for each age division and discipline.
