4-H SHOOTING SPORTS MATCH - Shotgun August 10, 2025 – Topeka, KS Capital City Gun Club – 12200 NW 4th, Topeka, KS

Lyon County 4-H Shooting Sports will be hosting a shooting sports match for shotgun, trap and skeet. This match is a state qualifier, no awards will be given. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 10-18.

Registration begins at 8:00. - each county needs to verify their shooter's information when checking in for correct age, birthdate and discipline. State Qualifier and 2025 State Match rules will be followed. Please check the State 4-H Shooting Sports Match Rules for additional information. All youth entering the competition must have completed instruction in their home county 4-H Shooting Sports program for the discipline entered. Shooters 4-H age 10-18 are invited to participate. NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is 10 years old before Jan. 1, 2025.

Registration form and fees are due by August 3, 2025. Late registrations only accepted to fill relays. We will only accept registration from one person per county. We will squad and assign times for the shooters, upon sign-in. Fees will be \$20.00 per shooter per event. Shooters will need to bring equipment and shells - NO RELOADS. All other state match rules will apply. NO BARRELS RESTING ON TOES, FOOT OR POINTED AT ANY PART OF THE BODY! Ammunition Specifications: Factory loaded shells only, no larger than 12 ga. with a maximum shot size of 7 1/2 lead shot and a maximum shot charge of 1 1/8 oz.

Shotgun: Trap: Shooters will shoot 2 rounds of 25 for a total of 50 at 16 yards. The shooters will shoot 5 shots in each of 5 positions, take a short break between each round of 25 shots. The 50 shots (2 rounds) will be the qualifying score as per State Match rules. Current ATA and 2024 Kansas State Match Rules apply. To qualify for the State Match in Shotgun Trap, the minimum individual score is 35 out of 50. Shotgun Skeet: Shooters will shoot 50 clays. The 50 shots (2 rounds) will be the qualifying score as per State Match rules. Current NSSA and 2024 Kansas State Match Rules apply. To qualify for the State Match rules. Current NSSA and 2024 Kansas State Match Rules apply. To qualify for the State Match in shotgun skeet, the minimum individual score is 30 out of 50.
