

2025 Jackson/Nemaha Bullmasters' Shooting Sports State Qualifier – Smallbore Rifle and Pistol



August 16, 2025—Horton Shooting Range 1099 King Fisher Rd. Horton, KS

The Jackson/Nemaha Bullmasters will be hosting a shooting sports match for Smallbore Pistol & Rifle. This match is a state qualifier and will follow the 2025 State Match Rules. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 12 to 18.

NOTE: the minimum age to participate in the State Match is 12 years old by Jan. 1, 2025

Registration forms and fees are due by Monday, August 4. Late registrations only accepted to fill flights. Fees are \$15 per discipline. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. - each county needs to verify their shooter's information when checking in. No awards will be given; this match is for qualifying only. There will not be a concession stand.

Smallbore Pistol – We will follow the current edition of the NRA rules for Timed & Rapid Fire. Each shooter will need to have a current handgun permission form on the firing line. No hypervelocity, hollow point, tracer or explosive ammunition is allowed. Clear chamber indicators are required. We will use B16 targets for slow fire; 10 minutes for 10 shots, B8 targets for timed fire & rapid fire. Timed fire is 20 seconds per string of 5 shots, 2 strings, rapid fire is 10 seconds per string of 5, 2 strings of 5 at 25 yards. The qualifying score is 125 out of a possible 300.

Smallbore Rifle - We will follow the current edition of the NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules for 3P. Any safe rifle not excluded by the National Minimum Standards & Best Management Practices using .22 short, long or .22 long rifle cartridges. We will be using the Orion/Scopes 50m 6 bull targets. We will shoot 10 shots in 3 positions: prone, standing, & kneeling. Time limits are: 1 minute per record shot in prone (10 minutes), 2 minutes per record shot in standing (20 minutes), and 1.5 minutes per record shot in kneeling (15 minutes). Sighting shots will be shot within the time limit for each position. The qualifying score is 175 points out of a possible 300.
